

How to log your cache visits on Geocaching.com Basic Tutorial

1. Click on **Hide and seek a Cache**:

*There are multiple ways to search for a cache. The GC number is one of the easiest ways to make sure you're logging the correct cache. However you choose to locate the cache listing, the process for logging your find is the same

2. Scroll down the page and search by Waypoint:

By keyword: Find

By Areacode (US Only): Find

By waypoint: Find

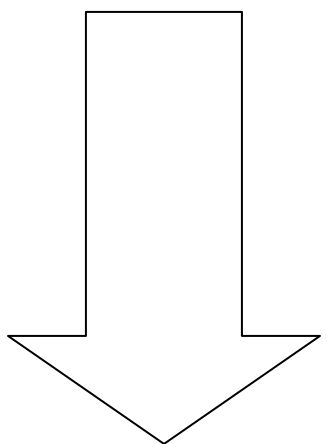
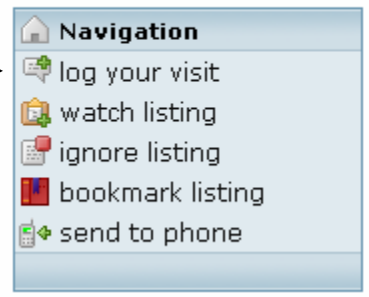
Or, Caches found by username: Find

3. Enter in a waypoint. (this is the GCxxxx). Click find.

4. In the upper right hand corner, click on 'Log your visit.'



5. Select the type of log.
6. Enter in comments if you choose.
